

Eyelash extensions are a beauty enhancement that require simple, yet gentle, care in order for them to last longer and stay in good condition.

Reminders

- I. Eyelashes need to be dry and have no mascara on them prior to eyelash extension application. If you wear eye shadows and liners on the same day, you will want to re-apply over it afterwards. Waiting 2-4 hours after appointment is best for re-application.
- II. If you wash them, they will last longer.
- III. Best to pat them dry and then brush. Brushing is usually THE solution.
- IV. You are given a dry mascara wand after each eyelash extension procedure at our spa.

Aftercare Recommendations

- Be gentle. No rubbing or pulling on your eyelash extensions.
- Keep your eyelash extensions dry for 24-48 hours after your appointment. You may wash your face in the sink using a washcloth, avoiding the eye area and submerging the face during this timeframe. Wash your face this way to maintain longevity of extensions.
- Keep all oil based products, and moisturizers away from the eyelashes.
- · Oil does dissolve the adhesive, causing premature eyelash extension shedding.
- Please do not pull on your eyelashes. Keep your fingers off of your eyes unless cleansing them.
- Brush your eyelashes daily. Brush the eyelashes gently if you notice something cattywampus.
- Eyelash tinting needs to be done before your eyelash extension appointments. Please remember to ask your aesthetician if you are desiring to add this treatment, or you can book both appointments online.
- No eyelash lifts (LVL/lash perm) 48-72 hours prior to eyelash extension appointment.
 Recommend one week prior to a fill or full set, adding curl to the natural eyelashes, so that the extensions adhere more easily to the natural eyelashes.
- Best to avoid saunas, facials, or swimming, within 24-48 hours of application. Watch how
 close you are getting your face to a lighter, the stove, or oven when baking, dishwasher after
 a fresh wash, and even a freshly hot clothes dryer. The heat can singe your eyelash
 extensions.
- · Be aware of eyelash curlers. The can pull your eyelash extensions and natural eyelashes out.
- Please be careful and take specific care with makeup and remover.
- · No cotton on your eyelash extensions.
- Wash Your eyelash daily (after initial setting interim). Apply oil-free makeup remover. We enjoy Blink Lash Foam. Spray cleanser onto wand, brushing gently down and up the eyelashes, and rinse with warm water.
- If desired, mascara needs to be washable. No waterproof mascara.
- Blink Diamond Coating Black Sealant is designed to be worn with eyelash extensions and can be easily removed. It can also extend the amount of time the extensions stay adhered to the natural eyelashes, by providing a protective bond while amping up the look.
- Apply one coat of the sealant to dry eyelashes every 2-3 days, brushing from bottom to top for best results.
- Avoid attempts to remove any eyelash extensions on your own. Call to schedule a 30 minute removal appointment.
